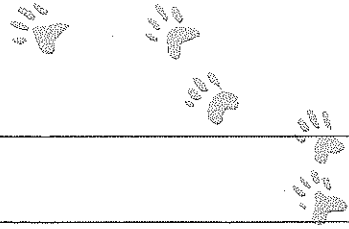


Field Observations

(hills, valleys, mountains)



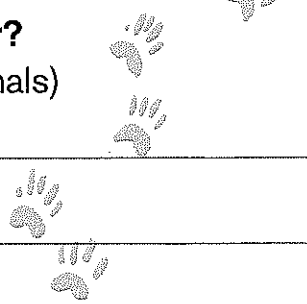
What plants did you see or smell today?

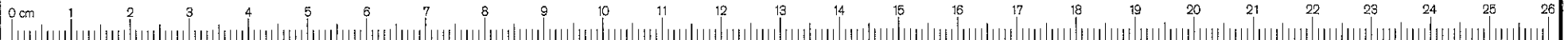

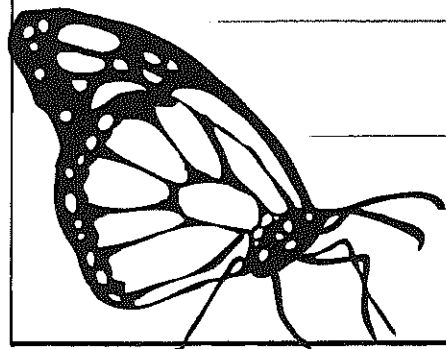

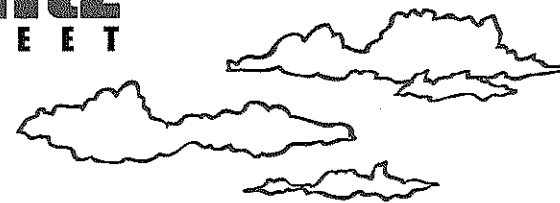
